Residual mix data plays a critical role in ensuring accurate Scope 2 accounting and preventing double-counting in renewable energy claims. The platform supports:

- Improved visibility of national and global residual mixes
- Better alignment with international accounting frameworks
- Enhanced confidence in environmental claims

By putting methodology into practice, this initiative strengthens the robustness of tracking systems and supports more reliable eRelenergy disclosure worldwide.

Updated issuance criteria in Taiwan

The I-TRACK Foundation Board has approved expanding the issuance criteria in Taiwan to include solar and wind facilities that are not benefiting from a Feed-in-Tariff (FiT). This change allows Registrants to request issuance from previously excluded devices in line with the normal residual mix deadline requirements.
